Northwest Mediation Center's history reaches back to the spring of 1985, when the idea of an organization dedicated to neighborhood conciliation was born and nurtured by community leaders. Since September of 2020, The Eviction Resolution Pilot Program (ERPP) has made up the majority of NMC's services. Throughout the last three years, we have seen a shift within the community, with a stronger focus on housing stability and rehoming services. We strive to help meet this need by helping community members create a calmer, more open space for dialogue and by helping people experience the wonders of conflict resolution. With the sunset of the ERPP, we are looking forward to reintroducing our organization to the community.

Throughout its evolution, always a non-profit, state/county authorized dispute resolution center, the organization's primary purpose has endured: to help people resolve their differences through peaceful conflict resolution. Conflict is found all around us. It's a part of our everyday experience whether it's an internal or external confrontation, small or big, simple or complex. All variations of conflict and problem-solving its resolution can be aided by the techniques and skills that NMC practices. We are looking to serve the community by providing this knowledge to those in conflict, teaching those interested in resolution and helping individuals understand how to handle conflict in a way that grows and preserves relationships.
